

Village Heritage Award

The purpose of the Village Heritage Award is to recognize and celebrate historic preservation in Cashiers. In selecting an award winner, the CHS Preservation Committee seeks to promote preservation of the village character of Cashiers and encourage adaptive reuse of existing structures.

Each year, the CHS Preservation Committee selects an award winner from nominated properties. Criteria used to choose the winning property include the following:

1. The property is located within the boundaries of Highway 107 north to the Continental Divide, 107 south to the Methodist Church; Highway 64 East to the Humane Society and Highway 64 west to the continental divide.
2. The architecture of the property is in keeping with the Old Village feel of Cashiers, with vernacular style, materials, and scale.
3. The property is an adaptive reuse of an older existing structure.
4. Attractive landscaping with native materials is used.
5. Moderate exterior lighting to enhance night sky visibility
6. Enhances Village feel and a sense of community
7. Enhances area businesses.

Nominations must be submitted in writing. In making a nomination, please note how the subject property meets the criteria above. You are encouraged to include information about the property's history and identify other ways in which the nominee promotes the preservation of the village character of Cashiers and encourage adaptive reuse of existing structures.
